- Injuries
- Disasters and disaster management
- CNS / stroke
- Medical Emergencies
- Nosocomial Infections

### **Guidelines for Poster presentation**

- **Size:** Posters should be no larger than 90 cm wide X 130 cm (high) (i.e. portrait, not landscape)
- **Layout:** the poster should be easily readable from a distance of about 2 meters. A carefully considered layout attracts interest, and facilitates for the reader to understand the author's findings and their significance.
- **Font:** Use large enough fonts so that it would be easy to read the poster. For headings, use at least a 48-point font size. For text, at least 18-point font size
- **Figures and Tables:** All figures and tables shall be clearly legible from at least 2 m, and each figure shall have a short, self-explanatory legend. Clarity is much enhanced by careful colour design and labelling of the figures and can be further improved by clear colour-coding
- **Mounting:** You must be able to mount your poster with pushpins or thumb tacks.
- **Presentation:** Specific dates and times will be allocated for Poster Presentations. Authors are requested to be present during these sessions.

### **Guidelines for submission of abstracts**

The abstract must be typewritten or computer printed, in ENGLISH, and should not exceed 300 words and should be in the format stated below

Please type or laser print using Arial font 11, within one A4 sized sheet in the prescribed format as stated below:

- You must indicate the **title, author(s), institutional affiliation** and the **presenting author's name must be underlined**. Use capital letters (uppercase) for the title.
- The text must be arranged according to the following headlines:
  - Introduction
  - Method
  - Result
  - Conclusion
- Please proof read the abstracts carefully as the abstracts will be printed as presented

- Abstracts should be submitted to our secretariat as **Soft copy** : saved as Microsoft word 6.0/2000/2002 or higher (IBM compatible formats)

- Abstracts should be mailed together with the Registration Form and the Registration Fee. Abstracts submitted without the registration fee will not be considered for Inclusion in the conference. Please submit the entire text of the presentation, along with the illustrations if any and the slides presentation in a MS Powerpoint presentation, in a CD to the secretariat at the time of submission of the abstract and registration fee.
